

# DOING BUSINESS (2018) – PAKISTAN

## Lahore and Karachi

### Starting a Business

#### Introduction

1. This briefing paper considers the current position of the DB topic of Starting a Business in Pakistan.
2. Specific commentary is made herein only to data relating to Karachi in Sindh province and Lahore in Punjab.
3. Pakistan ranks overall 144 out of 190 countries, as measured by the Doing Business 2017 report with a Distance to Frontier (DTF) of 51.77%<sup>1</sup>.
4. In relation to Starting a Business, Pakistan ranks 141/190 in 2017, with a DTF of 77.88.
5. It takes 12 procedures - 18 days; 12.4% of income per capita and no (0.0%) paid-in minimum capital to register a business in Karachi and Lahore. Statistics for men and women are the same.
6. The reasons for Pakistan's comparative low score on this indicator may be explained by the following factors:
  - a. Lack of automated systems at various provincial departments such as Excise & Taxation (E&T), Social Security (PESSI, SESSI), and Labor Departments of Sindh and Punjab. All applications are processed physically, adding to time and procedures.
  - b. No integration between provincial and federal government departments.
  - c. IT issues at the Virtual One Stop Shop (VOSS), prevent entrepreneurs to register efficiently.
7. The balance of this paper highlights both short-term solutions (to be considered capable of implementation within 100 days) and long-term goals to improve and benefit federal and provincial authorities on Starting a Business indicator.

	The various filing requirements post incorporation to start business merged as a part of Company Incorporation; i.e. appointment of directors, chief executive and nominee in case of single member company to be merged with incorporation process to reduce time for start-up of business
	Include business startup procedures, time and cost on the SECP website
	Translate existing and new forms, procedures, cost and guidelines in Urdu language
FBR to merge procedures	Merge NTN and STN numbers by establishing a single taxpayer ID
Data sharing	Establish data sharing mechanism between federal agencies (SECP, FBR and EOBI)
